Placement Profile - Basic Information for Applicants Johannesburg, South Africa

Placement Dates: September for 3 months.

Costs: You need to pay £500 towards the cost of your ticket. You need to allow between £950 -1300 for this placement including the costs of your ticket contribution, visa, vaccinations, insurance and personal spending money.

Pre-departure Training: Over 2 or 3 days in London.

What you will be doing: As a volunteer you will support JRS in their different areas of work. For example, you could work in the skills centres, do health visits or get involved in advocacy work to raise awareness about the reality of refugees. By participating in the programme, you will have a real chance to give hope and contribute to the lives of refugees in Southern Africa.

Where you will live: Volunteers will either be placed in local homes where they will live with a family and a local volunteer or in a community house where all volunteers will live together.
