Paul Martin is a Jesuit priest who has spent the last 30 years working in Guyana, South America. For much of that time, Paul has ministered to the Patamona, Macushi and Wapichan people of the amazon. Straddling the border with Brazil these three indigenous groups live close to the earth and in harmony with its creatures.

On this *Exploring Laudato Si'* day, Paul will examine the threats facing indigenous groups like this across the amazon, and as highlighted in the encyclical. He will consider the issues and ambiguities facing countries like Guyana which seek development on the one hand and the preservation of its natural resources on the other.
