Introduction

This prayer booklet has been prepared through the collaboration of Jesuit Missions, the Global Ignatian Advocacy Network (GIAN), partners, Fe y Alegria Students from Peru, Bolivia, Ecuador, Venezuela, and Guatemala, as well as companions journeying together through the ‘Transitioning Away from Fossil Fuels’ Conference in Santa Marta, Colombia, taking place from 24-29 April 2026.

Rooted in the Ignatian tradition of finding God in all things, these prayers invite us to reflect deeply on our relationship with creation, the impact of fossil fuels, and our shared responsibility to care for our common home, especially alongside communities most affected by climate change.

Each day of the conference focuses on prayerful discernment, justice-centered dialogue, and courageous action. These prayers may be used communally or personally, at the beginning or end of each day’s sessions, or as moments of quiet reflection.

God of justice and compassion,

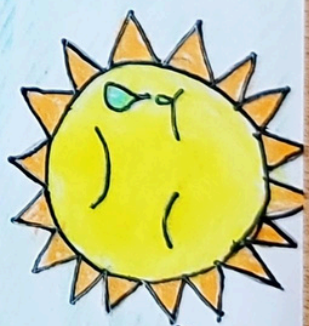
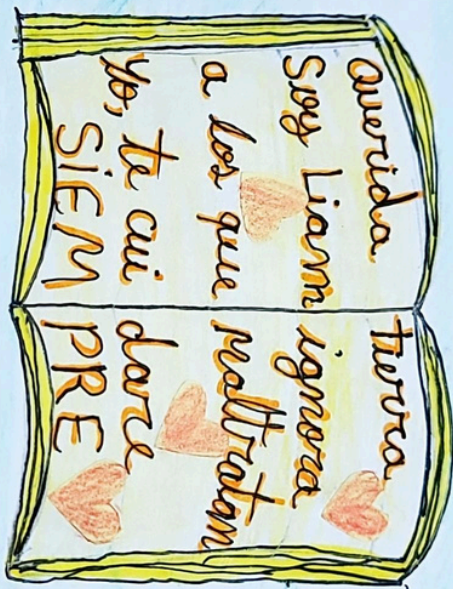

For Courage to Act and Lead

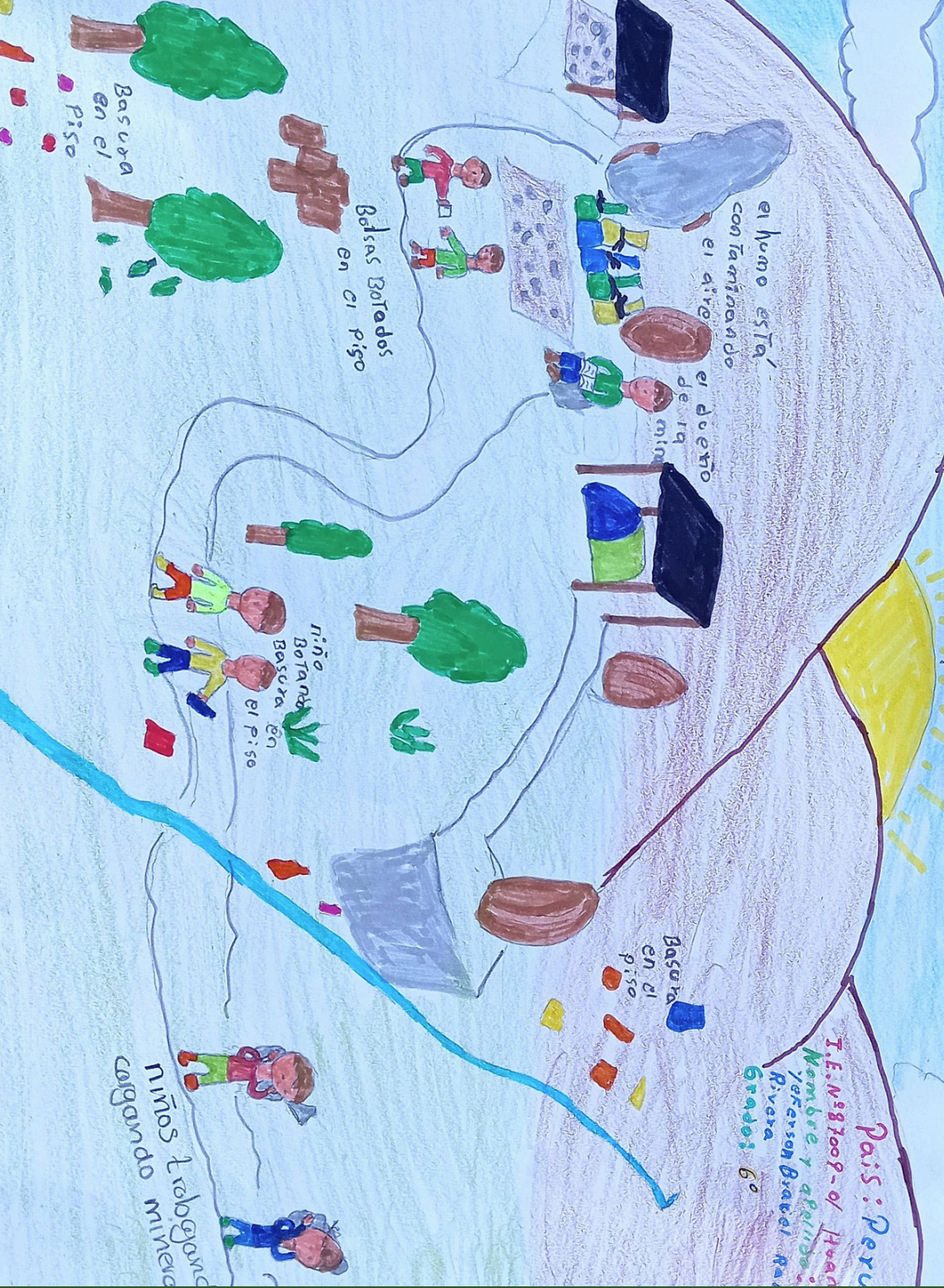
God of courage and hope,
